Greetings from Haiti! We hope that you are all doing well. We thank the Lord for you and the friendship and support you provide to us personally and to Living Hope Mission in Haiti. Since we last wrote, we have been busy working in various ways to further the Gospel in Haiti. Let us share with you what has been happening:

**Volunteer Teams:** We have been blessed by many volunteers investing their efforts in various projects with Living Hope Mission in Haiti. Since early December, we hosted groups from Lifetouch Inc., World Servants and Sidney, OH who all worked on the school in Fosse Capois. A team from PA worked on digging a fishpond there, and a team from Lima, OH shared their expertise by continuing the expansion of the church building in Juchereau. Volunteers from Florida worked on the completion of the Bakery in Pister. In addition, a team of volunteer doctors from OH and California ministered to the sick in Acul Samedi and DeRac. Thank you to each person who came and worked to share the Love of Christ with the needy in our communities.
