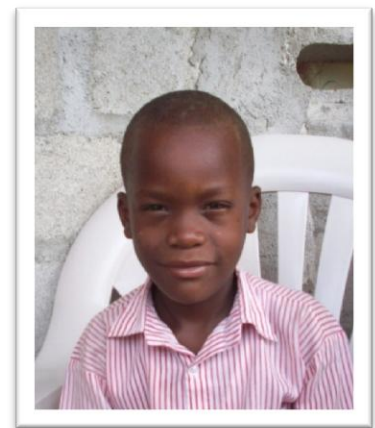
We hope that this finds you well. We want you to know that we are grateful to you for your partnership with us in ministering to the people of Northern Haiti!

Because LHM’s Scholarship Fund subsidizes the cost of running the church school in Wisley’s community, he is able to attend and is doing well. His favorite subject is Reading and his favorite game at recess is soccer.

Youveline Prevalus: Youveline, who some of you might remember as the young girl who underwent heart surgery in Texas, is now 19 years old and in her last year of High School in Cap-Haitien. She has done very well in school, scoring the highest grade of her class on the government exams last year. She hopes to continue her studies after high school with the goal of being a cardiologist.

Faunet Dorsan: Faunet has served for several years as a lay leader alongside Pastor Kenthe at the church in Roches Plates. He has always desired to attend university with the goal of studying agriculture and helping farmers in his area to grow better crops. At the request of his church, LHM is providing funds to help him attend North Haiti Christian University in Limbe.

LHM's Scholarship Fund helps both schools and individuals by providing funds for education. To give you an idea of the approximate costs:

A \$100 donation will help educate a primary school child for a year.

A \$500 donation will help educate a secondary student for a year.

A \$1000 donation will help a student attend university locally, and a donation of \$3000 - \$5000 will help a student study in the Dominican Republic.

School at Roches Plates Bursting at the Seams!

With the help of volunteers and generous donors, LHM also helps in the construction of school buildings. Built in the early 2000's Ecole Baptiste des Rachetes at Roches Plates has outgrown its facilities. This year, LHM along with volunteers and funding from Lifetouch, is working to add 4 more classrooms. THANK YOU to all who are involved in this important project!
